European Cheer League

Summer Open is now part of the European Cheer League (ECL). ECL is a league consisting of several competitions throughout Europe during 2017. The main goal of the ECL is deciding which teams are performing best throughout the year and not only at one single competition. The ECL give the teams the opportunity to compete against each other across Europe, although they don't necessarily compete at the same venues. A winner will be declared in each category when all the competitions are done – and the winners of select categories will qualify directly to the European Championship the following year – with all registration fees paid. In addition, the winners of the senior categories will receive prizes and discounts from Varsity.

Late signups and changes

Registration of teams and/or participants after April 30th will incur an additional fee of 10 EUR per team. Changing a submitted registration of athletes / coaches / assistants after May 13th will incur an additional fee of 10 EUR if the change is for the whole team, and 10 EUR per participant (change of names or similar)

Accreditation

A Norwegian passport is the only valid ID for accreditation for participants from Norwegian teams. Routines for accreditation will be the same as for Nationals 2017.

International teams must bring picture ID with date of birth (passport or national identity card).

Arena

Rykkinnhallen is a national facility for basketball and is maintained by BVHIF. The facility consists of two arenas, where one has several pull-out grandstands with a total capacity of 2000 spectators. A cafeteria can be found on the 2nd floor, adjacent to the entry to the grandstands. A BBQ will also be set up outside the arena. The address is Rykkinnhallen, Leirdueveien 73, 1349 Rykkinn, Norway.

Bus and trains

Bus (nr. 160) from downtown Oslo (Jernbanetorget, etc.) to Rykkinn. The closest stop will be Makedonien. The bus goes in a circle around Rykkinn, so the stop can be used for both arrival and departure.

The nearest train station is Sandvika station, approximately 6 km from Rykkinnhallen. Bus 160 to and from Rykkinn stops at this train station.

Car

E-18 to Sandvika; take the exit toward Hønefoss. Drive through two tunnels and take the second exit after the last tunnel (signpost saying Rykkinn). Drive past the church at Bryn, drive straight across the next roundabout, and take the next right (Leirdueveien). This road will stop at Rykkinnhallen

Shops / mall

Rykkinn Nærcenter is within walking distance from Rykkinnhallen.
