Belarus Open cheerleading championship is the competition of European Cheer League (ECL). The competitions will be held in Minsk, Belarus on the 30th-31th of March.

All the categories that are part of the competitions are open for International Teams.

TEAM SIZE:

Cheerleading and Performance cheer Team divisions – minimum 12 athletes, maximum 24 athletes*.

Group stunts – minimum 3 athletes, maximum 5 athletes.

Partner stunt -2 athletes +1 spotter.

Doubles – 2 athletes.

*For teams taking part in ECL minimum number of athletes is 16.

Children	Juniors	Seniors
6-11 years old		14 years and older for all Performance cheer and Doubles divisions;14 years and older for Team Elite;15 years and older for all cheerleading and stunt divisions.

AGE OF ATHLETES:

The age of athletes is defined according to the year of birth.

REGISTRATION:

Please, fill out the registration form in *attachment 1* and submit your registration via email to <u>cheerleader@tut.by</u>.

Deadline: 15.03.2019

17.03.2019: no more changes in registrations allowed after this point.

Each double may register one substitute athlete. This must be done before the very first ECL competition they are attending. This roster of three athletes (2 + 1) will be taken in account when calculating ECL points and determining the eligibility to qualify and compete in the ECU Europeans doubles divisions. If a substitute athlete is registered at a later time or if any of the athletes becomes a part of another doubles team (2+1), the ECL points for these new teams will be calculated separately."

REGISTRATION FEES:

Cheerleading and Performance cheer Team divisions - 150 EUR per team; Group stunt - 10 EUR per athlete; Doubles division. Partner stunt - 15 EUR per athlete.

PAYMENT INFORMATION:

Payment is available at place.

ACCREDITATION:

Teams' accreditation will be held on the 30th of March from 18.00-20.00. Team's head delegate should provide the following documentation:

- fully-completed registration form with medicine stamps and medic's signature (*attachment 1*);

- fully-completed safety document with athletes' names and signatures(*attachment 2*);

- the document with fully-paid registration fees.

On the day of competitions after the official warm-up of each team each athlete's ID will be checked. All athletes will be asked to show their passport or picture ID stating date of birth and full name.

Violations in accreditation procedure can lead to team's disqualification.

MEDICAL CARE:

Medical care will be available during Belarus Open cheerleading championship. Ambulance will present on site during competitions.

INSURANCE:

We recommend that all athletes and coaches have insurance documents in case of any injures. The organizer is not responsible of any injuries that occur during official trainings, warm-ups and competitions.

MUSIC:

Music may be played on USB memory card. The music should be saved in MP-3 and contain the information about the team's name, division, age category. All music played at Belarus open cheerleading championship must comply with applicable copyright laws.

Each team is required to have a responsible adult remain at the music station that knows the routine and music. This representative is responsible for start the music and stopping the music in case of technical malfunction or injury.

INFORMATION ABOUT VISA:

Belarus is visa free for 74 countries up to 30 days on condition of arriving and leaving the territory of Belarus through the State border checkpoint of the Republic of Belarus "Minsk National Airport".
