Activities in 2018

Steering Committee has continued work and strategy from previous years and actively used Facebook page for promotion of events, results, reports from events, ...

Electronic system for calculating of results turned out to be a stable tool, which reduced the possibility of errors in calculations. Only problems that have appeared in identifying team names, because each organizer has written them differently. Electronic system is in the upgrade process also for the calculation of Doubles.

Implemented rules for qualifications of Doubles to ECC in the upcoming seasons.

Successfully was implemented hosting of second ECL event, 5 countries hosted second ECL event.

In 2018 ECL hosted 17 events which counted for the winner of ECL. Participation of teams in all divisions significantly increased only in Senior Team Cheer Pom and Junior Team Coed division stayed decreased versus last year figures. In ECL has participated teams from 16 countries.

In category Team Coed Premier, Senior became a winner, No Limit, Russian Federation (from 32 teams) in Team All Girl Premier, Senior became a winner, No Limit, Russian Federation (from 47 teams) and in Team Cheer Pom, Senior became a winner, Non-Stop, Russian Federation (from 39 teams).

In junior categories winner of ECL became in category Team Coed No Limit, Russian Federation (from 16 teams) in Team All Girl Lighters Russian Federation (from 61 teams) and in Team Cheer Pom, became a winner, Zvezdi, Russian Federation (from 72 teams).

Activities and plans in 2019

- Upgrade of electronic system also for the calculation of Doubles.
- Upgrade of promotions of ECL events and communication with the organizers.
- Stabilize operations in ECL Steering Committee.
- · Active search for new organizers for ECL events.
