About the federation;

The 'Cheerleading and Cheerperformance Verband Deutschland e. V.' (CCVD) is a German sports federation ('Bundesfachverband') that represents the interests of cheer sport on a national level. It was founded in 2007 and currently has over 21000 individual members, all of them split into approx. 300 clubs ('Vereine') and 15 state federations ('Landesfachverbände'). The CCVD has been a member of the German Olympic Committee (DOSB) since the end of 2017 and has one of the highest rates of youth sports in all of German sport. The proportion of female members (over 90 percent), as well as the advanced digitalization in all areas of the association are unique attributes of a young and innovative sports federation.

CCVD e.V. is recruiting for an open position (m/f/d) in the competitive sports department of the federation ('Fachausschuss für Leistungssport').

CCVD e.V. offers a fitting environment to prove your skills in a multifaceted job at a young and dynamic sports federation ('Bundesfachverband'), to accompany ongoing projects, as well as to conceptualize and implement new projects. We can offer a limited one year contract with up to **40 hours/week**.

An unlimited employment after the duration of the one year contract is a possibility. The job is remote and can be absolved **working from home**. Furthermore it is required to attend up to 8 in-person meetings / national team training sessions (potentially overnight and on weekends).

Your tasks: *Depending on your specific employment contract and qualifications, your tasks include;*

- technical sport-related cooperation within the elite sports department
- further implementation of the elite base structure at state and national level ('Sportstützpunkte')
- further development of the CCVD training conception framework
- transfer of knowledge in regards to coaching content while liaising with the coach education department (possibly preparing content and assisting in online lectures)
- coordination of potential funding and further development of our elite sports department in connection to our national competition structure, working closely with the federations' events team
